2023 Udall Scholarship U.C. Berkeley Campus Application Instructions

Application Materials Deadline:
Noon, Tuesday, February 15, 2023

No late materials will be accepted!

Applicants must be nominated by UC Berkeley's Udall Scholarship Committee to be considered by the Udall Foundation. UC Berkeley may nominate up to eight students (four students who study the environment and related fields; and four Native American or Alaska Native students in fields related to health care or tribal public policy). The campus deadline allows the Berkeley committee time to carefully review applications and select nominees before the foundation's March deadline.

Applicants must make an individual advising appointment with **Alicia Hayes** (ourscholarships@berkeley.edu), the Udall campus representative, to gain access to the official online application on the Udall website (<http://www.udall.gov/OurPrograms/Scholarship/Scholarship.aspx>).

TO APPLY FOR A UNIVERSITY NOMINATION, YOU MUST SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING:

A complete online application includes:

- * Online application (available on Udall website) which includes the following below
- * Essay (800 words) related to the Udall Foundation's core values
- * Transcripts for all colleges attended
- * Three letters of recommendation

All materials, including letters of recommendation, must be submitted by 12:00pm on February 15, 2023.
