Campus Deadline: Noon, Wednesday, February 15, 2024

Late Materials will not be accepted!

Applicants must be nominated by UC Berkeley's Strauss Scholarship Committee to be considered by the Strauss Foundation. UC Berkeley may nominate three students. The campus deadline allows the campus committee time to carefully review applications and select nominees before the foundation's March deadline.

Applicants should make an individual advising appointment with **Alicia Hayes**, the Strauss campus representative, as soon as possible at ourscholarships@berkeley.edu.

TO APPLY to be considered for university nomination:

- **Application Summary form** (typed) (available on the Strauss website)
- **Resume** (one page) that includes your work history as well as your current and past community service
- **Personal Essay** (one page) discussing your most significant current and past community service activities.
- **Project Proposal** (4 pages, including budget and timeline – with 1.5 spacing minimum)
- **Two letters of recommendation**- if working with a partner organization, also submit their letter of support. Letters should be sent directly to Alicia Hayes at ourscholarships@berkeley.edu.
- **Unofficial transcripts from all colleges attended**
