



## **2024 Harry S. Truman Scholarship U.C. Berkeley Campus Application Instructions**

**Campus Deadline: Noon, Wednesday, January 17, 2024**

Late Materials will not be accepted!

Applicants must be nominated by UC Berkeley's Truman Scholarship Committee to be considered by the Truman Foundation. UC Berkeley may nominate up to four students. The January campus deadline allows the Berkeley committee time to carefully review applications and select those nominees who seem most competitive before the Truman Foundation's February nomination deadline.

Start early and read the "Guidance to Candidates" on the Truman website (<http://www.truman.gov>) carefully before (and after) completing the application. The National Scholarships Office provides individual advising to help students prepare competitive applications. You must make an advising appointment with the Truman campus representative, **Alicia Hayes**, at [ourscholarships@berkeley.edu](mailto:ourscholarships@berkeley.edu) to register for access to the online Truman application.

TO APPLY to be considered for university nomination:

- Schedule an advising appointment with the Truman Campus Representative, Alicia Hayes, to gain access to the online application at [ourscholarships@berkeley.edu](mailto:ourscholarships@berkeley.edu).
- Complete and submit the online application, including the policy proposal section.
- Submit unofficial transcripts from ALL colleges attended and send them to Alicia Hayes at [ourscholarships@berkeley.edu](mailto:ourscholarships@berkeley.edu).
- Submit three letters of recommendation, each focusing on a different aspect of your potential as a candidate at <https://form.jotform.com/222214769867063>:
  - Commitment to a career in public service
  - Leadership abilities and potential
  - Intellect and prospects for continuing academic success
