Please note that instructions provided by the Sperry Fund may contradict those on this page. In those cases, please follow the instructions below.

- * **Beinecke Campus Application** (download from Beinecke website)
- * **Personal statement** (1,000 words) describing your background, interests, plans for graduate study, and career aspirations. The statement should include a discussion of some experiences and ideas that have shaped those interests, plans, and aspirations.
- * **Resume or C.V.**
- * **Unofficial transcripts** from all colleges and universities you have attended
- * **Three letters of recommendation** from faculty members who can assess your intellectual curiosity, character, and potential for advanced graduate study (submit via Jotform link)
- * **Artist's Statement** (for MFA candidates only)
- * **Financial Aid Data Sheet** (only if nominated)
- * **Certification of Eligibility form** (only if nominated)

Email all materials, except letters, to ourschol-coordinator@berkeley.edu by the campus deadline.
